Willunga Hillclimb

Old Willunga Hill Road is a popular stage of the Classic Adelaide Rally – one of several major, internationally-renowned events held in the region annually. The uphill timed section of what is normally a public road is a twisty 2.69km in length.

The secret to fast times is smoothness and maintaining corner speed without hitting the Armco barrier on the driver's left or rock-face on the right.

Full details of the event are included in the Supplementary Regulations sent to those delegates who nominated participation on their NatMeet registration form.

Competition cars have been classified as per MSCA of SA categories.

Competitors' fastest time will be used to allocate NatMeet points within classes.

Trophies will be awarded to the quickest driver in each class, and for the most consistent times achieved across all classes.

A single spectator viewing area (John Yeate's lookout) is located mid-way up the hill (car parking entrance off Victor Harbor Road). Please follow spectator marshalls' instructions and do not cross the safety barriers.

The Hillclimb program commences with a photo-shoot involving all NatMeet attendees in their MX-5, double/triple-ranked part-way up the course. Cars will then proceed to the top and from there to one of three assembly points via Victor Harbor Road: the spectator viewpoint, competitors' assembly area in Willunga, or McLarens on the Lake funkhana venue.

After a familiarisation lap, hillclimb entrants will do 2-3 officially timed runs (barring hold-ups, incidents or inclement conditions).

Funkhana

The Funkhana at McLarens on the Lake - Serafino Wines complex involves drivers and their passenger competing in 3-4 novelty events, executed in low gear.

It's a fun way to earn NatMeet points for yourself and your Club – even a trophy for the achieving the highest (and lowest!) aggregate score across all funkhana events.
