NatMeet IX – Points scoring overview

A points scoring system will be operating for the duration of NatMeet.

Every registrant has the opportunity to score points, simply by participating in all program activities. Each delegate is awarded 100 points at registration; event helpers receive bonus points in appreciation of their assistance throughout the Easter long weekend.

NatMeet entrants' scores over the four-day event are used to determine the Individual National Champion and Champion State winners. The points scoring system takes account of distance travelled by MX-5 to NatMeet, individual participation rate, concours, hillclimb and funkhana rankings, any bonus points awarded, and the ratio of members per club in attendance.

Points allocated for each NatMeet 2010 program activity have been published on the web and a hard copy is included in your registration pack.

A Ranked Points Formula will be used to determine position in competitive events. This formula is also applied to distance travelled calculations. The formula is:

$$\text{No. of points} = (n - r + 1) \times \frac{100}{n} \quad \text{where: } n = \text{number of delegates/competitors in class} \\ r = \text{ranking in the event}$$

For the concours, delegates receive points as awarded by judges of their MX-5 (dual entrants each earn the points).

Event judges are selected at the discretion of the organizers: the Mazda MX-5 Club of SA. For all awards, the judges' decision is final and not open to discussion.

Your NatMeet points will be progressively tallied and trophies awarded at the Presentation Dinner. Individual delegates' scores and overall NatMeet 2010 placings will be made available after the event.

Although there's a competitive side to NatMeet, the real aim is for attendees to have a whole lot of fun.

Just remember, participation is the key to earning individual points and points for your State club ... so come on, join in!
